3 Instructions

Authors are requested to submit their paper electronically through the online submission interface not later than (please check the official webpage at <http://www.eusar.de> for the correct date). Submitted papers must contain unpublished material. Manuscripts must be submitted in electronic form only. The accepted electronic file format is Portable Document Format (PDF). When transmitting their paper, authors of accepted papers are considered to have read and accepted the Copyright Policy (see www.eusar.de).

At least one full registration is required per paper. Inclusion of accepted papers in the conference proceedings (CD-ROM, bibliographic databases) is conditional upon receiving payment for at least one full registration per paper latest by (please check the official webpage at <http://www.eusar.de> for the correct date).

3.1 Paper Formatting Guidelines

The total length of a paper must be *at least 2 pages but* should not exceed 4 pages. Papers exceeding 4 pages will not be considered, regardless of the technical quality. It is recommended to use the EUSAR templates for preparing the manuscript. **Please have a look on our websites www.eusar.de for all paper formatting guidelines.**

Your paper must be compliant with the following paper formatting rules:

- The page format must be A4 (21.0 cm x 29.7 cm).
- The paper abstract must be set in one column layout with single line spacing and should not be longer than 100 words.
- The paper must be set in two column layout with single line spacing.
- Use Times New Roman font, the text must be at 10pt with a line spacing of 12pt, the paper title 16pt, the section title 14pt, and the subsection title 12pt.
- The paper must contain complete contact information of at least one of the authors (postal Address, phone, fax, and e-mail).

- Figures, tables and equations must have separate sequential numbering.
- Do not number pages, and do not use footnotes.
- MS Word users: Embed all fonts, tables, charts, figures and images within the text.
- Avoid Asian or Cyrillic characters and unusual acronyms.
- Submit your paper as unprotected pdf file only.

3.2 Awards

There will be awards for the Best Paper, Best Poster and three Best Students contributions. For the Student Awards the paper must not exceed two authors and the first author must be a student or a PhD student. During the registration process this circumstance has to be highlighted, if the paper is submitted for the Student Award. The five awards will be presented on the last day of the conference.
