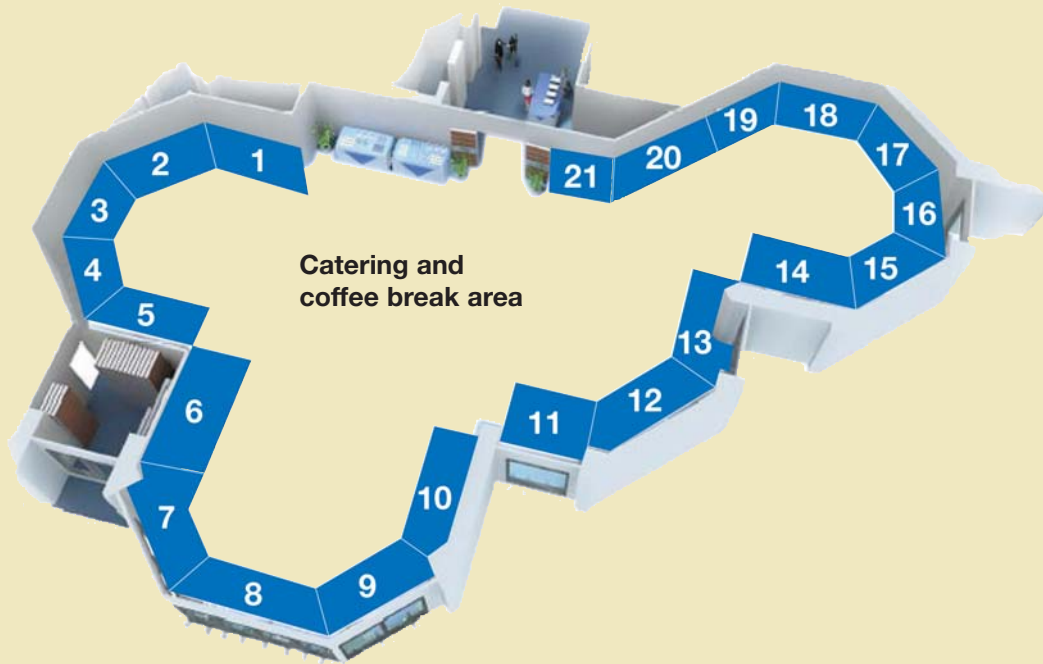

Any exceptions to this policy will be reviewed by the Management Committee which retains the right, in its sole discretion, to refuse or deny any application submitted, in which case any deposit shall be refunded.

Exhibition Space Fees

Before March 16, 2009:	195,- €/sqm +20% VAT
From March 16, 2009:	250,- €/sqm +20% VAT

Space cost include:

- General clean-up

Exhibition space at the telecon 2009 is available from 6 sqm and increments thereof as shown in the attached floor plan. Single booth spaces may be combined to form larger booths. Booth space will be sold on a first come, first served basis upon receipt of the Application and Contract for Exhibition Space with full payment.
